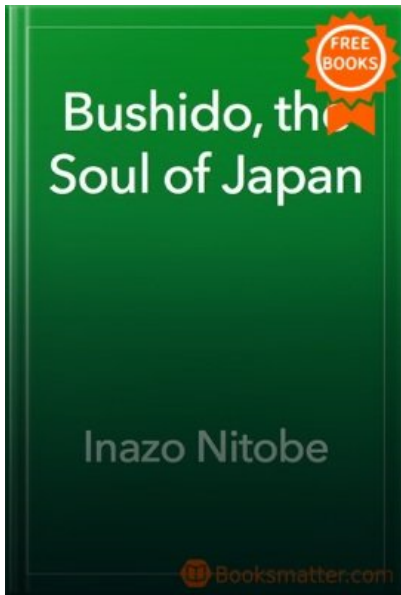

Early in his life he expressed the desire to be a "bridge over the Pacific" and he devoted much of his life to promoting trust and understanding between the United States and Japan.*

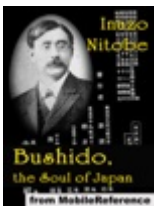

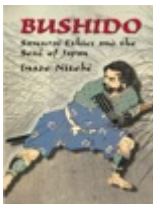
